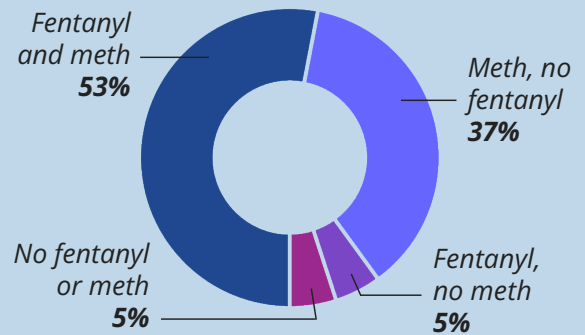


Syringe Services Program Survey

2025 General Summary

Summary

- **1,694 eligible syringe services program participants** from 24 programs across the state!
- **Most people used fentanyl or meth,** often both.
- **Most people smoked drugs (90%),** about half inject (44%).



We asked

What are the top two most important things you get at this syringe exchange?

Top responses

- Safer use supplies
- Hygiene supplies
- Narcan/naloxone
- Food & drinks
- Wound care

One person said **"A smile"** was the most important.



84% of respondents carried a Narcan/naloxone kit in case of an overdose.

Most people said they would see a health care provider and/or a mental health provider at the syringe services program.

Most people were interested in several treatments/services to help with their substance use.

What about smoking supplies?

89% of respondents got smoking supplies here in the past month.

59% said smoking supplies are the reason they first came to the SSP (among people who started coming in the past five years).
