Robrina Walker, PhD

is Associate Professor in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center, Dallas, TX. Since joining the UT Southwestern faculty in 2008, Dr. Walker has helped lead the Texas Node, one of 18 groups in the National Drug Addiction Treatment Clinical Trials Network (CTN) funded by the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA). Currently, she is Co-Lead Investigator of the CTN0068 ADAPT-2 multi-site study of pharmacotherapy for methamphetamine use disorder; Co-Investigator of CTN0090 MBC4OUD, a study that is developing universal screening and clinical decision support software for primary care settings; and Co-Investigator of the COMEBACK study, a NIDA-funded study evaluating how to connect people recently released from jail to HIV treatment.
