is an Associate Professor in the Department of Medicine at Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU). Dr. Englander is founder and Principal Investigator of the Improving Addiction Care Team (IMPACT). Dr Englander is working to change the standard of care for hospitalized adults with substance use disorder by redesigning care and shifting our view of addiction from one of shame and stigma, towards one that embraces belonging, treatment, and healing.

Dr. Englander has received numerous awards including being named one of the *Portland Business Journal's* "Top Forty under 40" in 2015 and one of the American College of Physician's Hospitalist TOP DOC in 2012.
