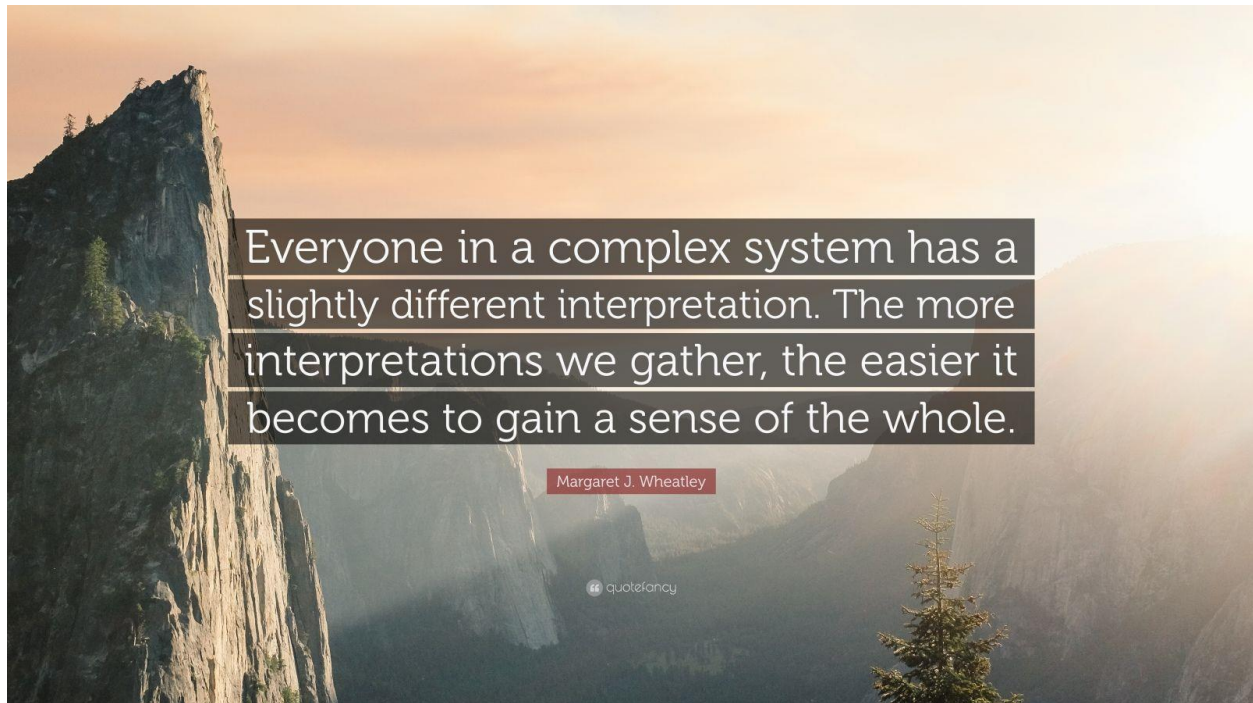


Lived Experience - Level Setting Meeting Design

- This is a spider web – many pieces fit together, starting with this group and then coming together with the larger group. Elephant and the six blind men



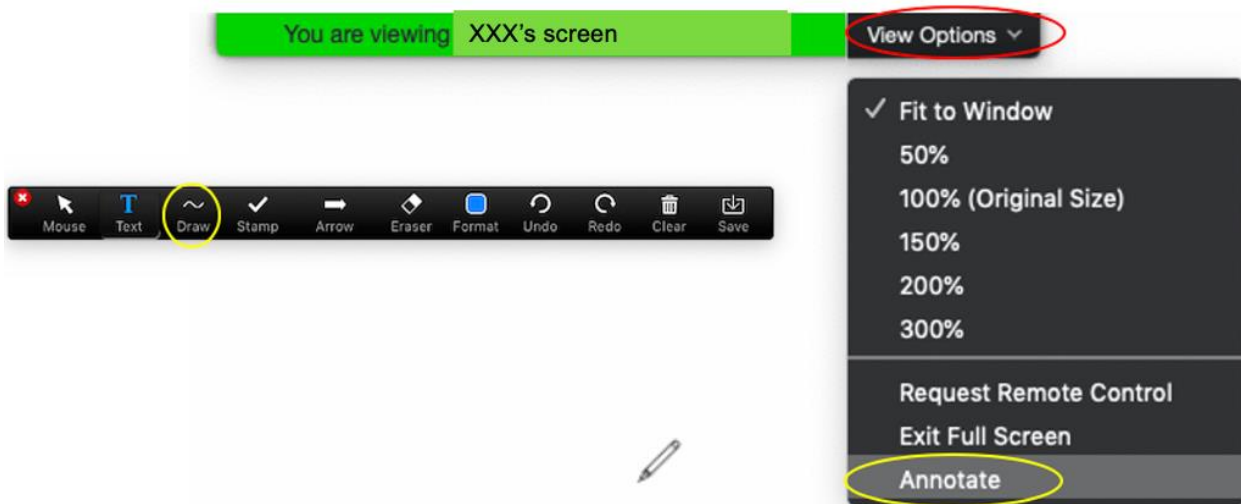
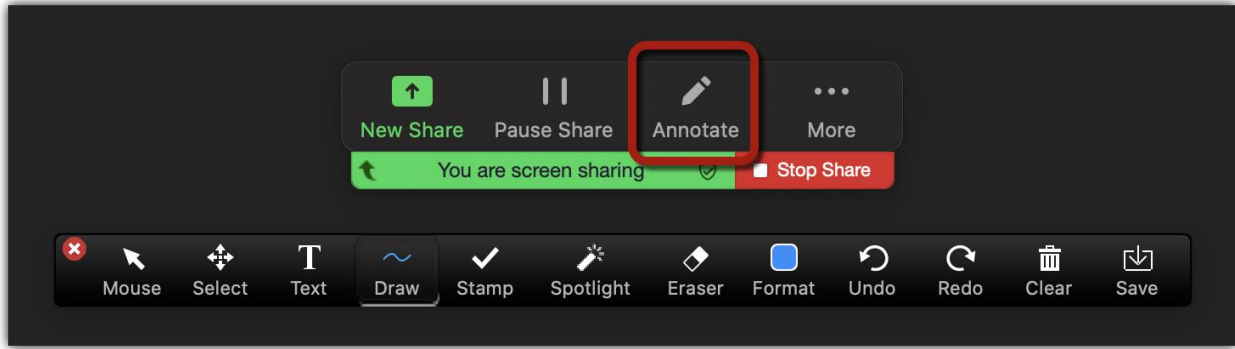
- There is no “right” or “wrong” here; all persons, thoughts, ideas and feelings are equally respected.
- This is a safe place to share your perceptions, feelings, and lived experiences of substance use disorder and law enforcement interaction, as well as the lived/living experiences of people who you work with.
 - a. This level-setting meeting is intended to be a time for ppl with lived experience to share, learn and acknowledge the current context of SUD (which may include your lived experiences and trauma) and identify ways to move forward (which may include addressing SUD related trauma in the future).

Ultimate goal/vision (5 minutes)

- Background to the project, BLEA training development that led to this work
- The outcomes of this co-design process are completely open and await your input and participation going forward in subsequent meetings with others in your area and region who are also dealing with SUD.

- Things to think about as we go along:
 - If you were designing a local program to “improve interactions between law enforcement officers and persons who use drugs” what would that look like?
 - If you were designing a statewide program, what would that look like?
