
Thanks for taking our Syringe Services Program survey!

Here's what we learned from you.

Most people used opioids and stimulants.



Most people don't share injection equipment.

Only 1 in 8 people shared a syringe in the past three months. **Only 3 in 8** people shared cottons or cookers.

Build of 4 people wanted safer drug smoking supplies. Q How many people do you know who smoke but don't inject? Average was 11.

What's going on with fentanyl?

 $\frac{3\%}{42\%}$ said fentanyl was their "main drug," but

64% of people who used fentanyl on purpose said it was a pill.



23% said it was a powder.

<u>Overdose</u>



1 in 4 people who used opioids **had an overdose** in the last year. People who used fentanyl overdosed more often, 27% compared to 20%.

COVID-19

Over 1/3 of people were vaccinated for COVID-19. **One quarter** of unvaccinated people were either interested in or neutral about getting the vaccine.
