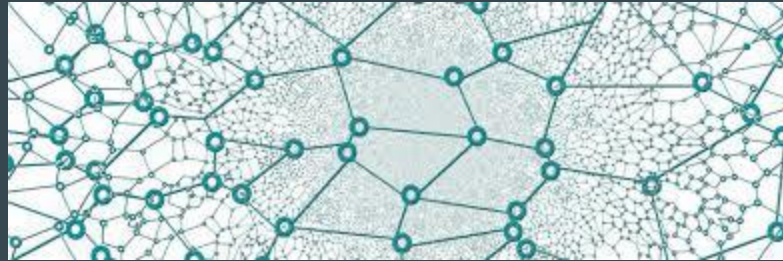

Emergence - something new is born - also the *groan zone!*

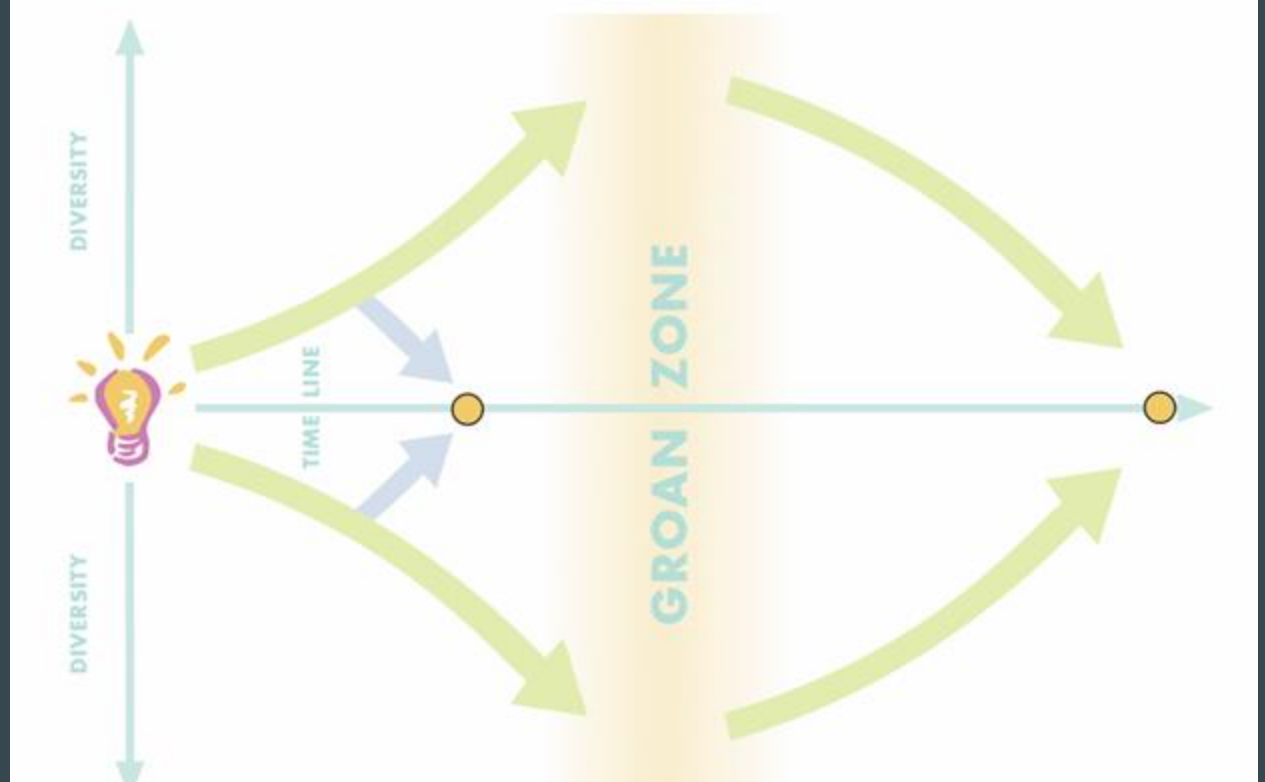
Convergence - the moment we know what to do next and begin planning and implementing.

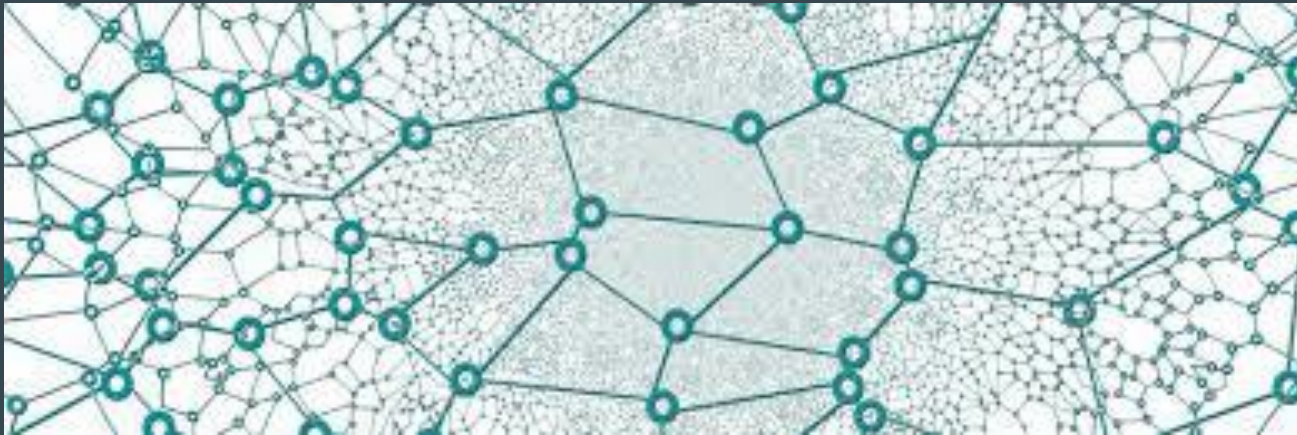

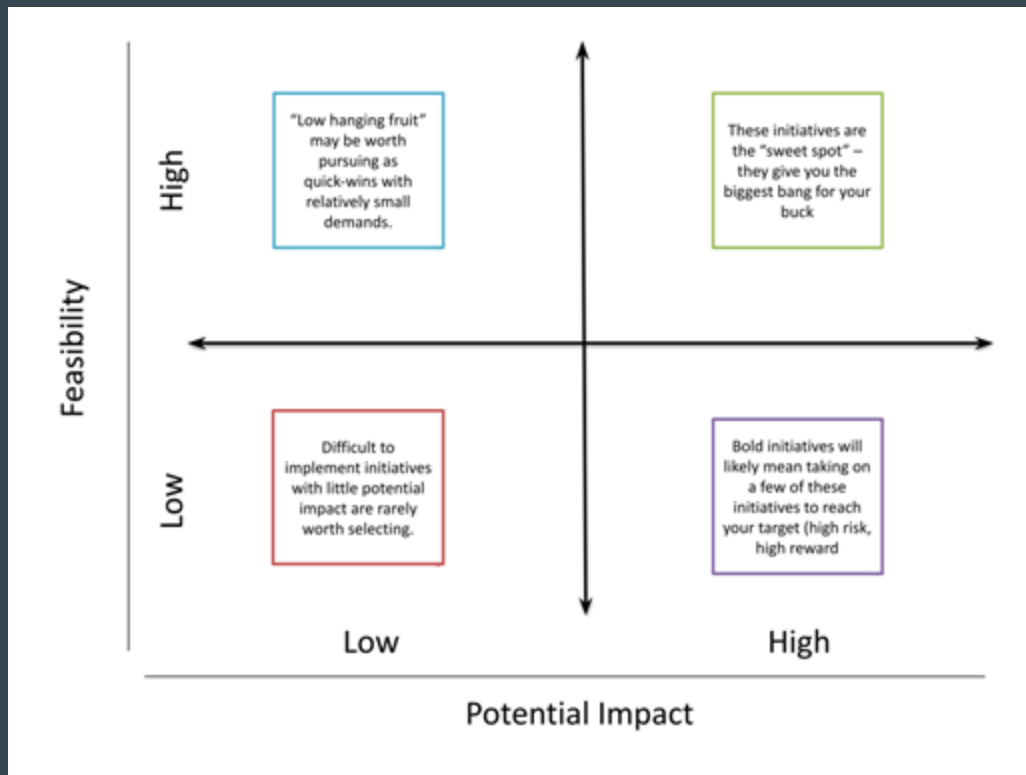
